in Colorado with minimum grade point
average of 3.0.
- A member of CWFHA during the 2010-
2011 program year.
- Must be enrolled in an
accredited graduate program.
- Available to serve as a member of the
CWFHA Membership Committee as
Student Liaison for the 2011-2012
program year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Application letter (max 3
pages) containing the information
below:
 - Reason for applying for the
scholarship.
 - Short-term and long-term career
goals.
 - The role of the female health
administrator (present and future).
2. Copy of school transcripts from all
undergraduate and graduate
institution(s) attended.

3. Faculty letter of nomination. A copy is acceptable if the faculty member has already sent this letter separately.
4. Letter of nomination by CWFHA member (**optional**).
