SPEAKER BIO

Philippa C. (Pippa) Marrack, PhD is a world class and world renowned female scientist. Her primary focus is on T cells and the immune response.

She has worked in her lab at National Jewish since 1979. Funded by numerous granting agencies over the years, she also holds the prestigious title of Howard Hughes Medical Institute Investigator.

Dr. Marrack serves on many boards and committees and has been awarded numerous awards which include: Royal Society Wellcome Foundation Prize Winner and Lecturer; Member, American Academy of Arts and Sciences; University of Colorado Distinguished Professor; The Louisa Gross Horwitz Prize-Columbia University; Fellow of the Royal Society; The Rabbi Shai Schacknai Memorial Prize, Hadassah University, Jerusalem; L'Oreal UNESCO for Women in Science Award; Bonfils Stanton Award for Science and Denver Business Journal Scientist Award.

Together with her husband and partner in science - Dr. John Kappler, she and their colleagues have been authors on 378 peer reviewed journals.

Pippa is a role model for women in science and has mentored many future scientists, both male and female.

She and her husband have two grown children and have recently become the proud grandparents of a little boy and a little girl- making this a very special time in life for Dr. Marrack.
